	Question	Max 5 Points
1.  (21)	<p><i>(Behaviour management)</i>: A plan of the Unit is displayed and the relevant areas are pointed out:</p> <p>A young person is being uncooperative in the medical room and is refusing to leave the room. It has come to the stage when the young person needs to leave the room to allow the doctor's surgery to continue. How would you manage this situation?</p> <p>What safety factors would you need to take into consideration ; in the medical room, during movement, in the unit</p>	
2.  (14)	<p><i>(Health, Safety &amp; Security)</i>: A member of your staff has come to you to request that he be allowed to bring his band in to perform for all of the girls in the Games Hall next Friday evening?</p> <p>What would you need to consider before coming to a decision?</p> <p>If agreed, what strategies would you put in place?</p>	
3.  (14)	<p><i>(Health, Safety &amp; Security)</i></p> <p>You notice that a young person is about to be given cough medicine that is out of date? What are the issues and your response? (You may also ask: a young person is complaining of a headache and wants a paracetamol. What are the issues in this case?)</p>	
4.  (4)	<p><i>(Flexibility)</i></p> <p><b>Flexibility : Working in a Secure Residential Care can be challenging and unpredictable.</b></p> <p><b>For example;</b> It is Monday morning, you had arranged for an extra member of staff to work in order that a young person could be taken on an outing as part of her Care Plan, she has been looking forward to this outing.</p> <p>A member of staff is also required to attend a Scottish Executive Review of another girl. However, a member of staff phones in sick, bringing the number of staff back to three (+ yourself). How would you proceed?</p>	
5.  (19)	<p><i>(Initiative)</i> :Please give me your response to the question we posed earlier about the Management Scenario : <b>Jenny a young woman on remand has cut herself very seriously with a piece of compact disc. She may require hospital treatment.</b></p>
